Reading Books



We believe in the importance of regular reading and expect children in Year 1 to be reading at home at least 3 times a week. It is important that this is recorded and in the Reading diary.

This year children will have a reading book that is closely matched to the sounds they have been learning in their phonics lessons. We continually assess children's knowledge of the sounds they know. Children will read their book in school 3 times with an adult, and the same book will be sent home to consolidate and build on reading fluently with expression.

Reading books need to be returned every day! Children will not be able to receive a new book until the current one has been returned.

Children also choose a 'Read Together' book for home. These are for you to read to/with your child


