English



During the Autumn Term we will be focusing on a number of different fiction and non-fiction based on our termly themes 'Amazing Nature' and 'Location, Location, Location.'

Handwriting and presentation are a big focus during Year 2 English lessons and children will be carrying out handwriting practice daily. We are learning to write pre-cursive letters ready to join up letters later in the year.

We will also be working with the children on reading comprehension and promoting enjoyment of reading. Please make sure they are read with at least 3x a week and their reading diaries are signed. Pleasure ensure your child brings their diary to school every day.

In writing, we will be exploring lots of different writing formats including stories, fact files and instructions. We will also look at using a range of punctuation when writing sentences.


Welcome to the new academic year.

Mathematics



Throughout the Autumn Term, Year 2 children will learn about a variety of topics in mathematics. The focus for this half term are:

- Number
- Place Value
- Addition and Subtraction

It is important that the children understand that maths is all around us and we use it every day. Great opportunities for discussions at home are in shops, telling the time, reading numbers, weighing and many more!

Each week, the children will do an arithmetic lesson as part of their maths curriculum. This supports the children when answering the questions they will see when they take any form of assessments.

Reading

We believe that reading is a vital skill for children and that it is important that children read at home regularly. We expect all children in Year 2 to be reading at least 3 x a week. Please sign your child's home school reading diary as this will be checked each day and children rewarded for reading at home which we monitor. In addition, we will read with your child each week at school both 1 to 1 and in a guided reading group. We will change your child's reading book when they have completed it.

This term our focus is on building children's understanding of what they are reading (comprehension), so we would appreciate your help with this. When reading with your child, ask them questions about what they have read.

Some ideas are:

- Who is the author/illustrator?
- What was the story about?
- Who were the main characters?
- What happened at the end of the story?
- Was the text fiction or non-fiction?
- If it was non-fiction can you show me how you use an index page/content page or glossary?
- What happened on page 7?
- What was your favourite part of the text/story?
- Any other general questions relating to the text.
- Stopping and asking what they have read so far and making predictions about what will happen next.



Homework

Children will have access the TTRockstars to begin working on their timestable knowledge this year. They will receive a login from their class teacher so they can access the platform at home. Children are expected to read at home at least 3 times a week and will be rewarded for doing so. Reading books will be changed in school and children are expected to bring their books and reading diaries every day so we can record when they have read with an adult in school.



Special Days

We are very excited about our Christmas Activity Day on **Friday 5th December**. A letter will be sent home with your child for you to book a slot in class where you can help your child make lots of fun Christmas themed crafts.





Please come to school in your PE kit as children will still not be getting changed in school. Please ensure it is suitable for outdoor PE sessions and to wear all day (trainers, white t-shirt, black tracksuit trousers, shorts or leggings and a black jumper or tracksuit top.

The PE lesson times are as follows: Mondays and Wednesdays.

Spellings and Times Tables

After half term, your child will be provided with spellings to learn at home each week and will be tested every week. These spellings relate to learning in Phonics and English.

We will teach the Year 2 Common Exception Words and allow children to practise spelling these words in school. These are a set of words which should be spelled correctly in children's writing.

We would also appreciate your help with the learning of spelling when children come home with their weekly spellings to practise at home.

Each week after the half term, the children will be tested on their Year 2 times tables (2x, 5x and 10x). If you could help them to learn these, it would greatly support their maths work. We will begin with the 10 x table then work on the 5x and 2x tables during this term. Using Times Table Rock Star is a great way to practice at home.
