



# English

We have an English lesson every day. Throughout the term, we will be using a variety of text to allow us to practise writing for different audiences and purposes including writing descriptions, diary entries, short stories and non-chronological reports. Our class text for the Spring term will be The Thieves of Ostia.



Punctuation, grammar and spelling will continue to feed into all of our work and children will be trying to improve their skills. Children will also be taking part in reading sessions with a focus on summarising a text.

**4AW –Tuesday and Wednesday**


**4FB –Monday and Tuesday**

Children in Year 4 will be learning a variety of skills in PE lessons this term including dance, badminton and outdoor adventure activities. On P.E days, please ensure your child comes to school in PE kit. We recommend tracksuit bottoms, a t-shirt, a jumper and trainers.

# Maths

Children have a daily Maths lesson. We will link as much of our Maths to our Connected Curriculum topic '**Rotten Romans**' as we can. Our work this term will centre on the topics of multiplication and division, fractions, decimals and measurement. Children will be comparing and ordering decimals to two decimal places.



Our work on calculation methods will also continue so ask your child to explain these to you! Children will also be working on problem solving and reasoning using the calculation methods they have learnt.

Throughout the term we will continue to work on children's times tables daily. Children are focusing on their rapid recall of multiplication facts in preparation for the Multiplication Times tables check in the Summer term.

# Science

Just like in Maths and English, our Science topic this term is also linked to our Topic work. We will be learning all about **Teeth and Digestion** and linking it to life in the Roman time period. We will also be undertaking a topic on light. Ask your children about different types of teeth and what they're used for!
