# Year 5 Spring 2026



In Maths we are developing our knowledge from last term. We will continue to build our calculation skills both written and mentally. It is extremely important that pupils keep revising their times tables facts up to 12's as well as the related division facts.

We will be exploring fractions, including addition and subtraction of fractions, as well as working between mixed numbers and improper fractions. We will then move on to multiplication and division using written methods.

We will use all our skills to solve a variety of real life problems.



This term we are focusing on linking our work as much as possible to our 'Earth in Space' topic. Children will be using their imagination and creativity to write a non-chronological report about a creature that lives on the planet of Pandora from a film clip based on "Avatar" on another planet. They will also be writing a story based on the planet of Pandora. They will be learning lots of new skills to include in their writing. We will also be focussing on vocabulary carefully in order for it to have an effect on the reader.
