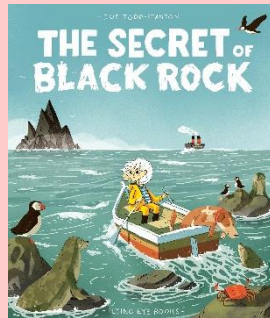
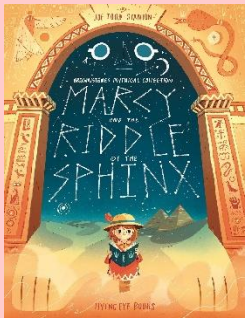


# English

Each day in English, we will continue to focus on a writing or grammar skill, which we will then use within a variety of text types and formats for our writing.

Punctuation, grammar and spelling will continue to feed into all of our work and children will be trying to improve their skills. Children will be taking part in reading sessions and we will focus on summarising a text.

**Read your reading book and bring it back to school with the diary signed at least 3 times per week.**

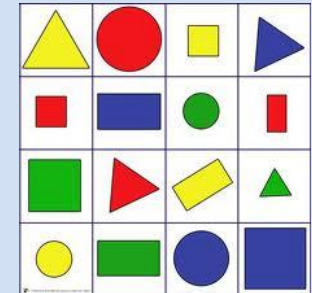
**Practise your spellings at home.**

# Maths

Children have a daily Maths lesson. We will link as much of our Maths to our Connected Curriculum topic '**The Ancient Egyptians**' as we can. Our work this term will centre on the topics of decimals, money, shape, translation and time.

Our work on calculation methods will also continue, so ask your child to explain these to you!



We are continuing to work on children's times tables. Children are being asked out of order facts as well as division facts to move onto learning the next x table in preparation for their times tables table check in June.

# Connected Curriculum

This term, we will be focussing on the history topic of “The Egyptians”. Within these lessons children will be answering several historical questions. Alongside this, children will be comparing the things we have in today’s modern society, with what existed back in Ancient Egypt.
