if they are unsure of a question, we can discuss it in school the following day.

- ✂ Help your child with their daily organisation (in preparation for secondary school) making sure they are on time and have their reading book, reading diary and come to school wearing their PE kit, when required.

basing our learning around recycling and helping to save our planet.

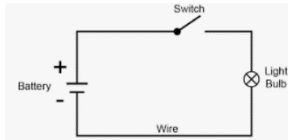
We will be thinking about Earth Day and how we can help to protect our planet.

be focusing on our Science skills and building electrical circuits as well as looking at the different symbols used when drawing circuits.

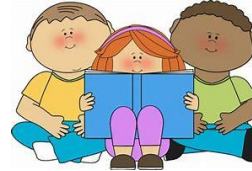
We will also be showing our creative
